

This is a suggested list of items for you to bring on your up and coming trip this fall. However, these are just ideas of items to bring.

LIST FOR GUIDED AND DROP CAMP HUNTERS

3 pairs of jeans
3 pairs of long johns
5 pairs of regular and insulated socks
3 warm flannel shirts and 3 lightweight ones
Always layer your shirts so they can be taken off as needed.
A small pair of Bo-Nocks (so they are not heavy around your neck in the field) and a Range Finder
Game bags - You will need 6 for an elk and 2 for a deer (This is to keep the game clean out in the field.)

2 knives and sharpener
2 boxes of shells

A WARM SLEEPING BAG

If you are comfortable with a scabbard on your saddle, you can bring one. Otherwise, we suggest you put a sling on your gun and put this across your back.

1 roll of surveyors tape
1 orange vest } 500 sq. in.
1 orange hat }

You must have solid orange. No orange camo or fishnet orange.
3 pair of gloves: 2 lightweight & 1 heavy

All of our tents are insulated and have propane heat & propane cookstove. There are cots and foam pads for all hunters. There will be a tarp on the floor of the tent to help keep your camp clean. Your camp has a sheltered outhouse.

Planning a daily menu is a necessity for preparing your meals. This is how you know how many groceries to bring and minimize excess items.

If you are going on a pack-in hunt on horseback, we are very limited on space and weight. You are allowed one duffle bag no bigger than 30" long, 14" wide and 12" high. **DO NOT** bring oversized bags. We cannot pack them. They will not fit into the panniers. **DO NOT BRING OVERSIZED BAGS.** You are allowed one duffle bag and one sleeping bag. If you want to put a small backpack on your back, you can. Packing any extra bags will cost you \$100.00 per bag. No Exceptions. I have put together a list of items to bring. You will find that it will be more than enough for a five day hunt. Remember you will have one set of hunting clothes to ride into camp (heavy coat, pants, boots, etc.)
